CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Disability) has been designed to prepare students to effectively support people with disabilities to maintain their skills, knowledge and independence while engaging them in meaningful and appropriate activities, social networks, and care in their own home or assisted living setting. The focus of this qualification is working within the Disability sector.

Qualification outline

Course duration

12 weeks in class or 24 weeks external (paper based and online external options available).

Funding

Requirements

- National police check (Working with vulnerable people).
- Blue card / Yellow card (can be applied for through HANMAC).

- commit to and meet set timeframes and complete studies outside of the classroom setting.
- complete basic computer based tasks.
