CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Home and Community) has been designed to prepare students to effectively support people who are ageing to maintain their skills, knowledge, independence, and health while remaining in their own home. The focus of this qualification is working within the Home Care sector.

Qualification outline

Course duration

12 weeks in class or 24 weeks external (paper based and online external options available).

- commit to and meet set timeframes and complete studies outside of the classroom setting.
